What do you think about pets? The latest data shows that there are more dogs and cats in Japan than children. In addition, pets live longer than in the past. People with pets think that their pets are family members. This means that the market for pet insurance will grow.


You have to pay animal doctors a lot of money when your pets are injured or sick. For example, when your large dog gets one surgery, the total cost is more than 80,000 yen. If your dog has no pet insurance, you have to cover the total cost out of pocket. Sometimes it costs too much to keep pets. Many people are afraid that they will have to lose their pet because they don't have enough money, especially if their pets often get sick and need to see animal doctors. If their pets have insurance, the insurance company pays (a part of) the cost. As a result, the number of people who buy pet insurance is increasing even if they have to pay for it every month. There is no public insurance for pets now, so ¹the private pet insurance sector has grown to make pet insurance less expensive. Pet insurance is good for animal doctors, too. Various methods allow them to increase the chance of animals' survival.

Pet insurance usually covers 50% to 100% of the total costs of health checkups, surgery, and medicines. In many cases, people have to pay at animal hospitals first, and after a while they get (a part of) the money back from the insurance company. Some companies offer a discount for people with more than one pet, and others have a 24-hour telephone service. However, pet insurance doesn't usually cover health foods and it is not common for the companies to offer support for everyday pet items. People have to buy those items. Moreover, many companies don't offer insurance for aged pets. So, getting insurance plan for young pets is a good idea.

The graph on the next page shows the number of pet dogs and the money spent on them. Health-related costs include the money paid for animal health such as checkups and health foods. We can learn from this graph that the number of pet dogs has decreased, and the cost for insurance has not changed much, but health-related costs have increased.
