


Nina : I guess you don't know much about him. Surprisingly, most cats stayed close to home. Usually, they only walked about two houses away.

Jake : Really? That's it? I always imagined mine was traveling around half the town.

Nina : Same! A lot of pet owners were relieved because it means their cats usually stay away from major roads.

Jake : That actually makes me feel better. I always worry he'll get into a traffic accident or something.

Nina : A female cat in the study walked over a kilometer away from her house.

Jake : Wow!

Nina : When the owner checked the GPS data, it showed the ²route to go back to her old house — the one she moved from.

Jake : No way!

Nina : Yeah! It shows that cats can remember places from their past really well.

Fast fashion is a business model to make and sell clothes very quickly and cheaply, and it has become very popular. It started in the early 2000s. People who live in developed countries can buy such clothes when they want. Instead of changing clothes for each season, fast fashion stores get new clothes many times a week.

[1] But this kind of business can be bad for some workers and for the environment.

The world makes more clothes than ever before. To make clothes cheaply, many companies use low-paid workers in the countries like India and ¹Bangladesh for ①labor. It is said that about 170 million children around the world have to work and many of them are in the fashion industry. This is because they do not need special skills. They just do simple jobs like ²sewing clothes or ³dyeing cloth. Some jobs, like picking up cotton, are much better for small children because (②) thanks to the size of their hands. These children have to work under bad conditions. They work long hours and get little money. They also work with dangerous chemicals. In 2013, a sewing factory building in Bangladesh fell down and 1,134 people including many children died there. The clothes they make are often thrown away easily.

Fast fashion also influences our environment. Every year, China throws away 26 million tons of old clothes. These clothes are put under the land. Moreover, cheap clothes use ⁴chemical fiber like ⁵acrylic and ⁶polyester. These are not natural like (③) or silk because they are made from oil. So, it takes hundreds of years for these clothes to break down under the land.

(④), fast fashion can have a negative impact on our health. Making and dyeing clothes causes 20% of all industrial water ⁷pollution. In fact, many factories put dangerous waste in local rivers. The local people use the water, and it may lead to cancer. Also, sending clothes all over the world creates a lot of carbon dioxide and global warming can be more serious. The fashion industry produces 10% of all carbon dioxide in the world. [2]

One way to help the environment is ⑤by changing how we get our clothes. Actually, some people now buy used clothes on the internet. The companies buy and sell our old clothes and other people can find them online and buy them for a cheaper price. There is another choice. Instead of buying them, we can wear used clothes at a low cost for a short period.

Some famous companies are also trying new things. For example, ⁸Adidas makes special clothes just for you. [3] ⁹Ralph Lauren has already started some sustainable ways for making their clothes.

Governments also have a role. In the UK, some people who work in the government wanted to talk about fast fashion's bad points, but their idea was not accepted. [4] However, Emmanuel Macron, the French

president and many clothing companies decided to work together to help the environment. “Less is always more.” This means we should buy fewer things to help the Earth.
